21103	Superintendent of Schools Report	Superintendent, Doug Nicholls, updated trustees and senior administration on the highlights of his report, including an update on the work of the C.2 committee, the addition of Grades 7, 8 and 9 Islamic School students into Composite High School, and the May 10, 2014 Spring Splash Event. Superintendent Nicholls introduced meeting attendees Joe Champion, Principal of the Fort McMurray Christian School, and Annalee Nutter, Principal of Walter & Gladys Hill Public School.
		Superintendent Nicholls mentioned the ECDP program and necessary increase in fees to \$500 per year, indicating the separate school board has also similarly increased their fees.
		Two options for the $2014-2015$ School Calendar are being discussed with various stakeholders. The full-day PLC Calendar would provide some cost savings in the transportation area and benefit all staff, both CUPE and ATA. Local CUPE and ATA Presidents, Lorna Tollman and Nancy Ball, will also be meeting with the Board to provide feedback on the calendar options.



Superintendent of Schools Report (continued)

The EDGE program will see the addition of a female component and will expand into Grade 3. It is currently being offered in Ecole McTavish, Westwood, and Ecole Dickinsfield.

The second Special Networks Committee Meeting was held on March 12th and meeting attendees were given the opportunity to provide their feedback on Calendar and outcome-based reporting.

Associate Superintendent, Allan Kallal, provided trustees and senior administration a brief financial report, indicating overall the District is trending better than budgeted and has \$6 million in reserves. Superintendent Doug Nicholls added the expectation is to bring in a balanced budget for the 2014-2015 school year.

Allan Kallal also updated trustees and senior administration on the impact of the recent Provincial Budget announcement, and the status of new school construction.

Spotlight on Education Presentation by Westview Public School

Associate Superintendent, Brenda Sautner, introduced Westview School Principal, Merrie-Rae Mitsopoulos. Ms. Mitsopoulos provided an explanation for the students' presentations, and expressed her appreciation for the mentorship provided by Westwood Community High School students. Westview students presented their projects.

Presentation by Student Advisory Team

Associate Superintendent, Brenda Sautner, introduced Education Department Coordinators Bobbi Compton and Myrna Matheson, and Composite High School student Stefan Eybers. Stefan described his commitment as a Student Advisory Team member, indicating the opportunity to engage with other students, the fabulous discussion, and the opportunity to present student feedback to the Board was invaluable.

Stefan asked trustees what they will do with students' feedback. Superintendent Doug Nicholls indicated senior management will be reviewing the feedback and determining appropriate follow up. Mr. Nicholls also indicated the senior management team has committed themselves to spending more time with students at upcoming Student Advisory Team meetings.

Trustee Mywaart commented that, as an example, trustees raise students' concerns regarding diploma examinations to the Minister of Education at every opportunity. Ms. Mywaart added students' questions become a living document with trustees and students' issues are raised whenever possible.

Trustees and senior administration thanked everyone for attending and participating in the Spotlight on Education.
