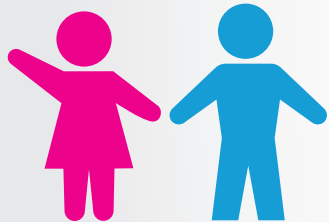

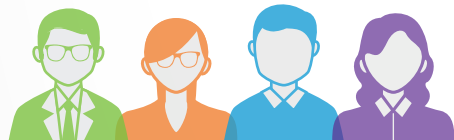


### 5596 Students

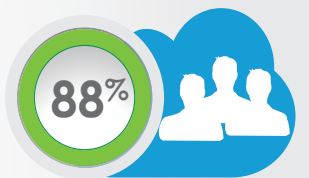


## Accomplishments

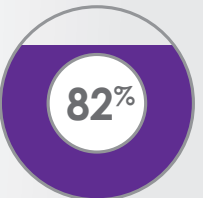


7% increase in Grade 6 and Grade 9 **Provincial Achievement Test** Results
