PRIORITY #1 - SUCCESS FOR ALL STUDENTS

FINANCIAL UPDATES As presented by Allan Kallal, Associate Superintendent of Business & Finance

- Based on the Budget assumptions and with current information on the budget, the Division is looking at a \$6.5 million deficit (this is subject to change as the budget is still under development and the funding manual was not received at the time of the report).
- The Weighted Moving Average for 2025/26 has been reduced to 2 years 70-30 but the supplemental growth grants were eliminated.
- The August 31, 2025 deficit will not be determined until the labour action and grants are finalized.
